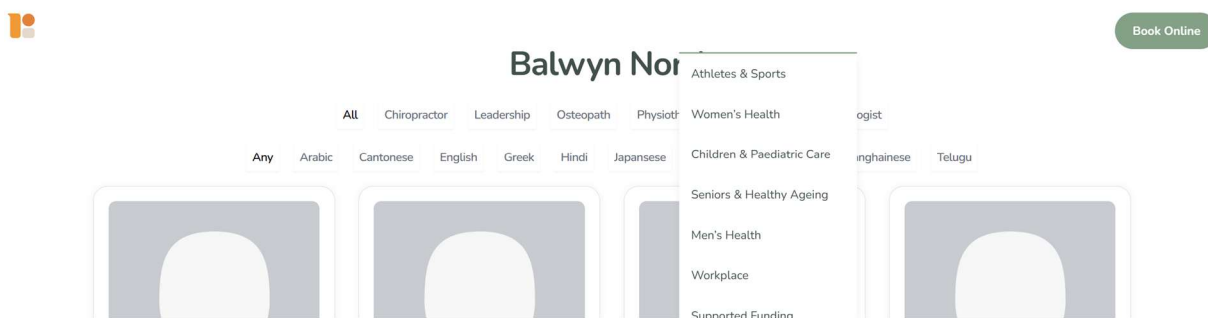

Menu Bar

Top menu bar and full logo on some pages doesn't show as background is also white eg Balwyn North Team page – can background on these pages maybe be changed to another light shade from our colour theme

What do you think of the below ideas:

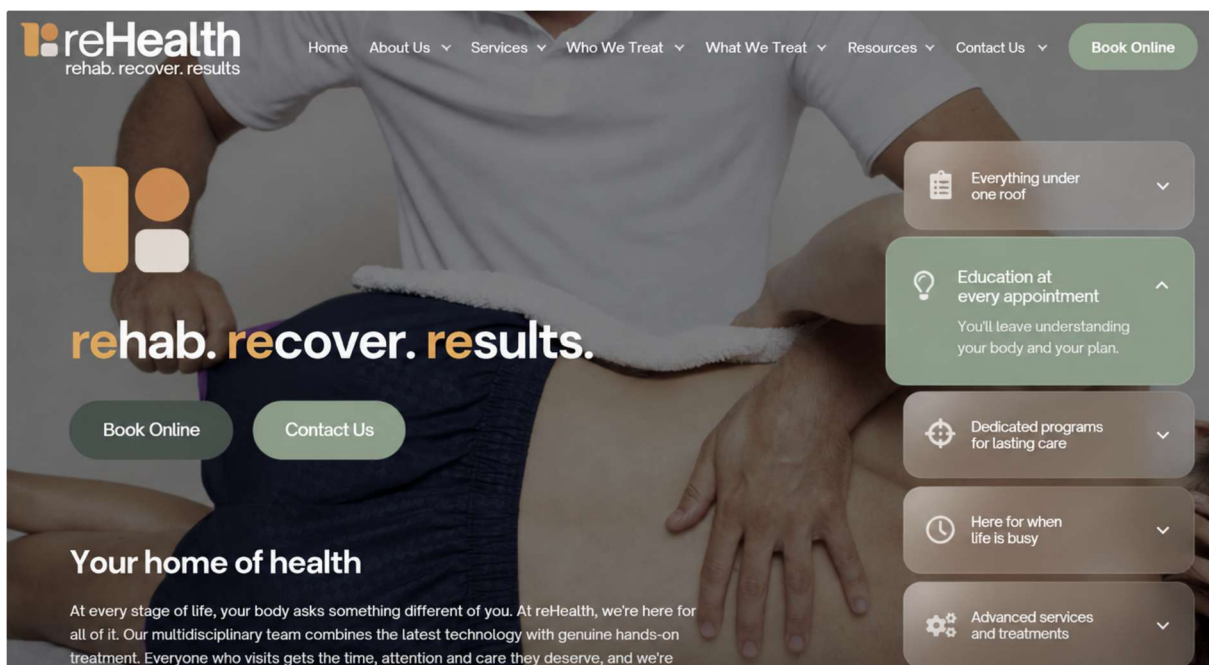
- Highlighting the “**Re**” in **Rehab, Recover and Results** in orange, so patients can more easily recognise the connection between them and the “**re**” in **reHealth**?
- Even (if not going overboard) doing this throughout for any headings with ‘Re’ words i.e **redefining** health..., **refreshingly** personal etc
- For the **five feature points** displayed vertically on the right-hand side of the homepage banner, we’d like each one to be interactive. The first thing I tried to do was click on them because they looked like buttons, and I think patients will naturally try to do the same.

When a user clicks or taps on a feature point, the box should expand to show the additional information currently included further down the page under “**The reHealth Difference.**” Only one box should be open at a time, with the others remaining collapsed.

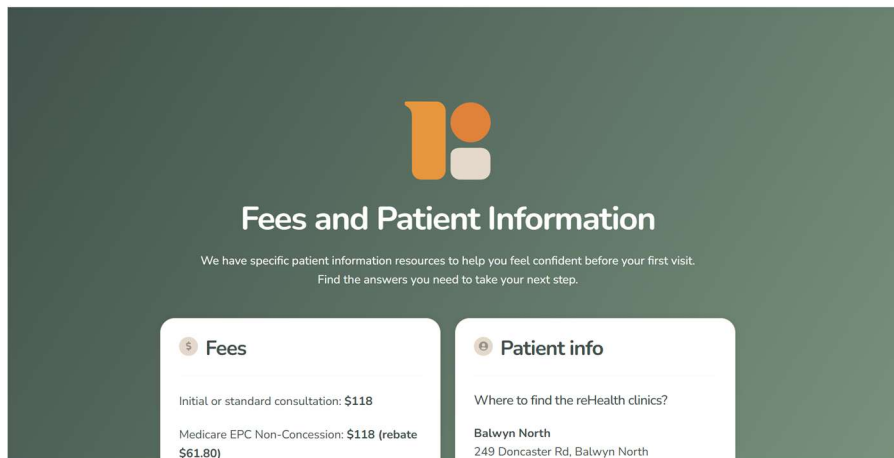
The selected box could also change to a slightly different shade when opened, making it clear which point is active. A small downward arrow could be included to indicate that each box can be expanded.

If this can be incorporated into the banner, we can remove “**The reHealth Difference**” section further down the page to avoid duplicating the information. The background design used in that section, featuring the repeated logo, could then be incorporated into another section of the page instead.

- Remove Fees and Patient info section showing on home page – leave this just on patient info tab should patients wish to access

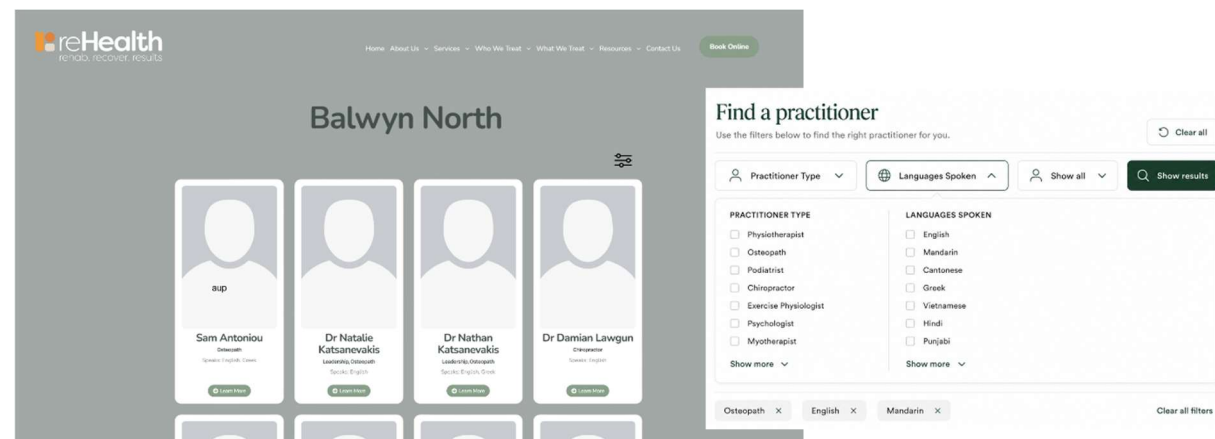
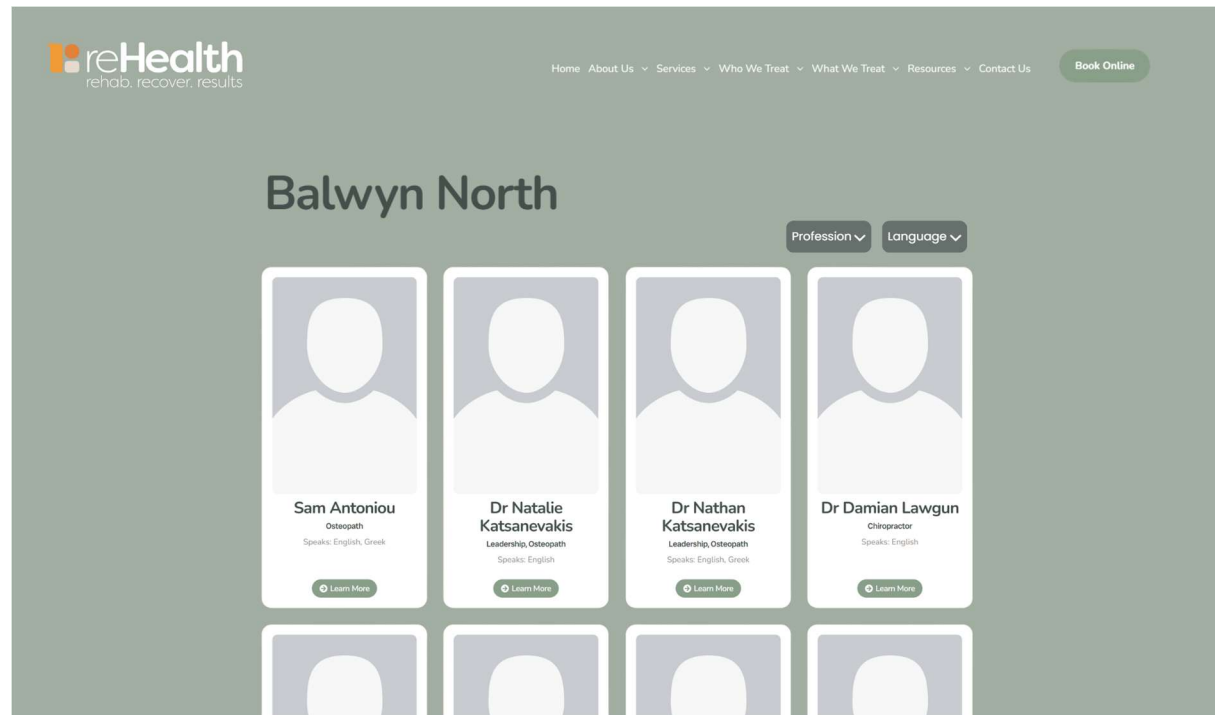


- Can we change 'Careers' to 'Join our Team' on About Us menu

The filters – can these be drop down selected instead rather than visible along top?

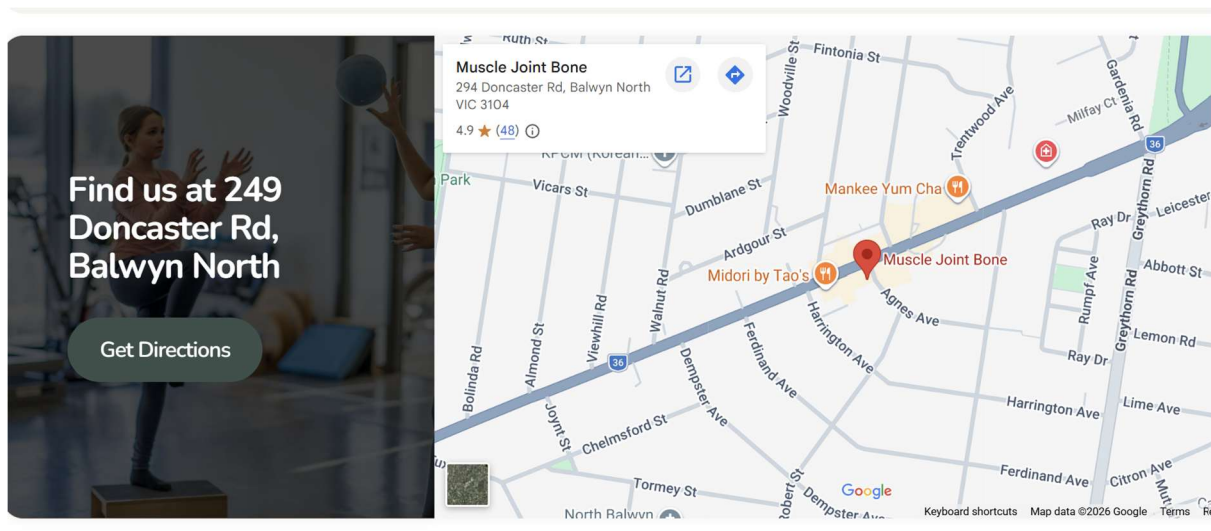

With the additional TAC and NDIS pages, can these sit as expandable pages under the main heading **“Supported Funding Programs”**? We could also move the current **“Workplace”** page into this section, so when patients click or hover over **“Supported Funding Programs,”** they can select from **TAC, NDIS and WorkCover etc.**

The **“Workplace”** page is intended to cover WorkCover, so would it be clearer to rename it **“WorkCover”** to make it easier for patients to identify?
